

DECISION Herbicide

READ THE DIRECTIONS LEAFLET COMPLETELY BEFORE MIXING OR USING.

HAZARD CLASSIFICATIONS: 9.1A, 9.2A

APPROVED HANDLER: This product must be under the control of an approved handler when applied in a wide dispersive manner, or by a commercial contractor.

RECORD KEEPING: Records of use as described in NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals must be kept if more than 3kg of this product is applied in one location within 24 hours.

ECOTOXICITY: Very toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container.

SELECTIVE HERBICIDE: Very toxic to some plant species. Spray drift hazard – do not allow drift outside the target area to occur.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children. Store in original containers, tightly closed and in a locked, dry, cool area away from foodstuffs, fertilisers and seeds. Store in accordance with NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid skin and eye contact and inhalation of spray mist. When mixing or applying wear appropriate eye protection, waterproof gloves, boots and overalls. Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after work.

EQUIPMENT: Apply using well maintained and accurately calibrated equipment. Clean equipment thoroughly after use.

DISPOSAL: Triple rinse empty containers and add rinsate to spray tank. Recycle empty container,

otherwise crush and bury in a suitable landfill.

FIRST AID: If swallowed do not induce vomiting. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with running water for several minutes. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash with soap and running water. If inhaled, immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. Call the National Poisons Centre **0800 POISON (0800 764 766)** (24 hrs) or a doctor immediately for advice.

SPILLS: Prevent product from entering waterways. Contain liquid spills and absorb with inert material. Sweep up solid spills without creating dust. Dispose of waste safely in a suitable landfill.

SHELF LIFE: When stored appropriately, this product should show no significant degradation for 2 years from the date of manufacture. Contact Rainbow & Brown for further information about the use of any product that is older than this.
